The riddims and riffs of the streets compress into a tried and true system, controlled and packaged for international success. All this is broadcast to the critical mass for consumption, sometimes at the cost of the music itself.

SOUND SYSTEM is a film in its early development stages.

Part of the process is organizing a pitch deck which can represent to interested talent the scope of the project— and even more crucially, its vibe.
